

MASON – THORNTON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Mason - Thornton Scholarship Fund is awarding scholarships for SCCAI courses (this includes the 45 hour National sponsored courses that replaces the demonstration report for the SRA) that will lead to a designation.

Fill out the application form and include an essay stating the reasons that entitle you to a scholarship. Important facts include; service to the Appraisal Institute (committee member, board of director, Regional Committee member, etc.), courses taken and passed, letters of recommendation and financial need.

To be eligible, you must be a member of the Southern California Chapter of the Appraisal Institute in good standing (see eligibility). Scholarship applications should be sent at least two months prior to the start of the course. If you have received a scholarship in the past, you still may be eligible to receive an additional award.

Requirements and Procedures:

1) Eligibility

- Must be an advanced Associate Member in the Southern California Chapter of the Appraisal Institute (SCCAI) in good standing. An Associate Member in good standing is an individual who: (a) holds Associate Member status with the Appraisal Institute; (b) engages in or has engaged in business activity identified by the Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice; (c) is not suspended from membership; (d) is not the subject of a disciplinary proceeding as defined in the Regulations of the Appraisal Institute; and (e) is not the subject of a peer review proceeding where the Associate Member has been sent an offer of punishable disciplinary action as set forth in the Regulations of the Appraisal Institute.
- Scholarships are for Certification level courses offered by SCCAI (Basic Appraisal Principles/Procedures, Business Practices & Ethics and USPAP do not qualify)
- Designated Members of the Southern California Chapter may also apply for a scholarship when pursuing another designation.



2) Required

- Complete application
- Resume
- 500 words or less essay stating the reason that this scholarship should be awarded. Suggested reasons include past or current involvement with this Chapter such as serving on a Chapter Committee, Branch functions, Regional service or AI national service, financial need, etc.
- Letter of recommendation
- Optional: Applicants should be prepared for a phone interview

3) Awards

- A percentage of the course fee not to exceed 75%
- You will be informed of your award via email or phone

4) Reimbursements

- Reimbursement for the scholarship will be made directly to SCCAI

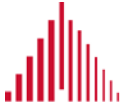
All portions of the application must be completed and all information supplied must be accurate or the application will be returned.
