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

County Background

- Medical cannabis cultivation banned since January
 2016 with two limited exceptions
- Recreational cannabis activities banned temporarily while regulations are developed
- Board appointed ad hoc subcommittee met regularly from March to September
 - Focused on these elements: taxation, land-use permitting, enforcement, business licensing, health impacts

Personal cultivation, for personal use, permitted in any dwelling or accessory structure.							

Development Standards

- □ Lighting Plan
- Landscape Plan and Screening Plan
- Odor Abatement Plan
- Prohibition outdoor cannabis cultivation, including within hoop structures - AG-I Lots 20 acres or less, AG-I-5 and AG-10
- Post-processing and packaging of cannabis

- products shall be considered accessory uses
- Cannabis operation cannot be located within 700-feet from sensitive receptor
- Lighting is prohibited in hoop structures
- Structures over 20,000 square feet DVP

State Temporary Licenses in SBC

- Requires an affidavit attesting to legal, non-conforming
- 986 applications to the state from 90+ cultivators
- 256 temp licenses issued; Second only to Humboldt
- □ 135 denied (13%) mostly due to wrong license type
- □ Balance (595) still pending
- □ 160 approved licenses for Carp area; 242 pending
- 91 approved licenses for Lompoc/Buellton area; 273 pending

Development Standards (cont)

- Odor Abatement Plan
 - Reduce odors that are experienced within residential zones
 - A description of all equipment and methods to be used for reducing odors
 - Certified by a Professional Engineer or Industrial Hygienist
 - Carbon filtration systems
 - Vapor-phase systems
 - Project siting practices
 - Local Contact
 - 24-hour a day availability
 - Notice to property owners 1,000-feet from lot
 - Complaint tracking and reporting system
 - 3 in 365 corrective action required

- Hoop Structure Lighting Prohibition
- □ M-RP Cultivation Indoor Only
- Greenhouse Lighting Requirements
- Post-Processing and Packaging
- Site Transportation DemandManagement Plan

- □ Home Occupation Prohibition
