

#### RETAIL EVOLUTION

Then the first enclosed shopping malls surfaced in the 50s, quickly followed by big box stores like K-Mart, Target and Walmart in the 60s.

THEN the Internet, with sites like Amazon and eBav.





#### **EB-5 ON STEROIDS**


- M+D secured \$80 million in foreign funding by way of the EB-5 Immigrant Investor Program.
- Green Cards for investor, spouse and children 21 and under in exchange for foreigners who invest \$500,000 to \$1,000,000 in a U.S. commercial enterprise that creates 10 jobs in the economy within 3 years.
- Thanks to those investors, nearly all businesses scheduled to open later this year are geared toward Koreans.
- The Source was fully funded by EB-5
